Colorado Members

Bank of Colorado | Estes Park, Colorado

Estes Valley Investment in Childhood Success funds childcare provider support and education. The \$500 will benefit efforts to increase childcare in Estes Valley.

First FarmBank | Greeley, Colorado

First FarmBank is investing in the future by donating to the Boys and Girls Club of Weld County. The goal is to support the future of their community.

Bank of Colorado | Fort Lupton, Colorado

The needs fulfilled by the Fort Lupton Food and Clothing Bank continue to grow. Bank of Colorado will use its \$500 to help give to the more than 8,000 people in need.

The Estes Valley is a unique and beautiful place in Colorado, and the Estes Valley Land Trust works to protect it from over-development. The Bank of Colorado will be donating its \$500 to protect properties and preserve the land.

Kansas Members

Union State Bank | Arkansas City, Kansas

Union State Bank will give 10 staff members \$50 to go out and do something good for the community. Union State Bank will add to the funds for a total of \$150 per project.

First Heritage Bank | Centralia, Kansas

No matter the size of a town, it can be difficult to find your destination when one is not familiar with the town. This project will provide a directional sign at the entrance of town that would show visitors which way to go to common sites. True Sky Federal Credit Union is starting a training program for students and women to learn about investing. The program is specifically designed for people who don't typically have access to this type of programming. Students who go through the year-long program will be encouraged to start an investment club and help teach future participants in the program. Funding from #500forGood will be used for materials and expenses during the meetings.

The Bank of The West | Thomas, Oklahoma

Thomas, Oklahoma, went too many years without a daycare. Since opening a year ago, it meant so much to the town. Still the facility can use help, including shade for the children in the yard. The \$500 will purchase a tree to add extra protection for the kids in play.
