Effective date: The effective date of the 2026 QCTs and DDAs is **January 1, 2026**.

The 2026 QCTs are based on MSA definitions published in OMB Bulletin No. 23-01 on July 21, 2023 and data from the 2020 Decennial Census and three sets of 5-year tabulations of the American Community Survey (2017-2021; 2018-2022; and 2019-2023).
